Bobbie Gerhart Nursing Scholarship

History: In addition to the many accomplishments achieved during her tenure at MVH and various positions throughout Premier Health, Bobbie Gerhart provides a legacy for future patients and nurses for decades to come through the Bobbie Gerhart Nursing Scholarship. Bobbie, a volunteer EMT and nurse, retired as MVH President and CEO and created an endowment to fund scholarships for nursing education. "I want to contribute in some way to individuals who are seeking out the nursing profession" she said. Bobbie began her career as a cardiology nurse at Good Samaritan Hospital.

Program Description: Scholarship recipient will receive \$1,000. The scholarship is to open to Baccalaureate (BSN) and Master's (MSN) degree seeking nursing applicants.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Miami Valley Hospital employee.
- Undergraduate applicants must have been formally accepted into a nursing program (if the four-year nursing program accepts the student prior to completion of prerequisites the student must have 2 years or less remaining until graduation).
- Graduate applicants must be enrolled in a program that leads to a master's in nursing.
- Student must be attending an NLN or CCNE accredited nursing program in the United States
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Scholarship monies will be utilized for tuition only and directed to the school's financial aid office.
- Monies awarded will not exceed tuition.
- The Scholarship does not have a post-completion work agreement.
