Kyle Combs Scholarship

<u>History</u>: Kyle Combs worked as a Patient Care Technician in Miami Valley Hospital's Advanced Care Unit. He was an energetic, caring young man whose dream was to become a nurse. His plans were tragically cut short when he passed away in a car accident. In his memory, Kyle's parents established a clinical education endowment through the Miami Valley Hospital Foundation. The endowment was funded by an annual golf scramble in Kyle's memory. Kyle's dream of serving patients along with his colleagues lives on through the educational opportunities made possible by this scholarship.

<u>Program Description:</u> Scholarship recipient will receive \$1,000. The scholarship is open to a Patient Care Technician on any Advanced Care Unit pursuing a Nursing degree; Associate (ADN) or Baccalaureate (BSN).

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a Miami Valley Hospital Employee.
- Undergraduate applicants must have been formally accepted into a nursing program (If the four-year nursing program accepts the student prior to completion of prerequisites the student must have 2 years or less remaining until graduation).
- Student must be attending an NLN or CCNE accredited nursing program in the United States
- Minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Scholarship monies will be utilized for tuition only and directed to the school's financial aid office.
- Monies awarded will not exceed tuition.
- The Scholarship does not have a post-completion work agreement.
